Join us on Thursday, March 25 for the first shooting of the NCACA Spring Fever Sporting Clay Challenge. Whether you are an ag consultant, grower, ag educator or manufacturer's rep, you are invited to come out for a great time and a great cause.

Sign up, bring your growers, employees, associates or just a friend and come out to Hunter's Pointe Sporting Clays, one of the top sporting clay facilities in the area just north of Washington NC. Get in a few practice rounds, enjoy some great barbecued chicken with iced tea and the famous Hunter's Pointe beans and then shoot a round of 100 clays from 14 stations.

Not familiar with sporting clays? No problem! This event is for everyone from Sharpshooters to Greenhorns. Sporting Clays is a shotgun and clay target shooting game that uses a series of stations typically arranged around a course; it is often described as "golf with a shotgun" since each group of shooters moves from station to station trying to break the most clays. It is quite popular with novice shooters and experts.

The stations on the sporting clay course provide a variety of shooting opportunities. At one station you might be shooting at a clay pigeon rolling across the ground (a "rabbit") while at another station you might be trying to hit a pair of clays flying through the air. Sporting clay courses also change slightly from week to week so if you shoot regularly over the course of a few months, you will experience a large number of different angles and velocities.

These events use the **Lewis Scoring System** which takes all the scores and divides them into divisions after the event is shot. So it doesn't matter whether you hit 90% of the targets or 10% of the targets; you are in the running and could win a prize. But whether you hit 'em all or miss 'em all this event is about having a blast and meeting others like yourself who are involved in agriculture and who enjoy the outdoors.

### Why are we doing this?

We spend some long hours in the field during growing season and while we do get together for two meetings annually, usually the agendas are full and we don't have a chance to get together informally and develop relationships as consultants, growers, educators and industry reps. And each year the NCACA awards scholarships to students pursuing an education in agriculture and we want to expand our program to ensure that we have a constant flow of good young minds entering this exciting and essential career field.

### What Do You Need To Bring?

We will walk the course which is one mile long. Much of the course is through the woods but it is open and with 14 stations you'll be stopping every 100-200 yards. You can wear shorts or jeans; sneakers, boots or hiking shoes, and a hat and sunscreen is a good idea. **You need to remember to bring your own gun and ammo (you'll need 125 rounds of 7½ to 9 shot), and eye and ear protection are required.** You also might want to bring a range bag, back pack and/or shell pouch to carry your ammo around the course.
